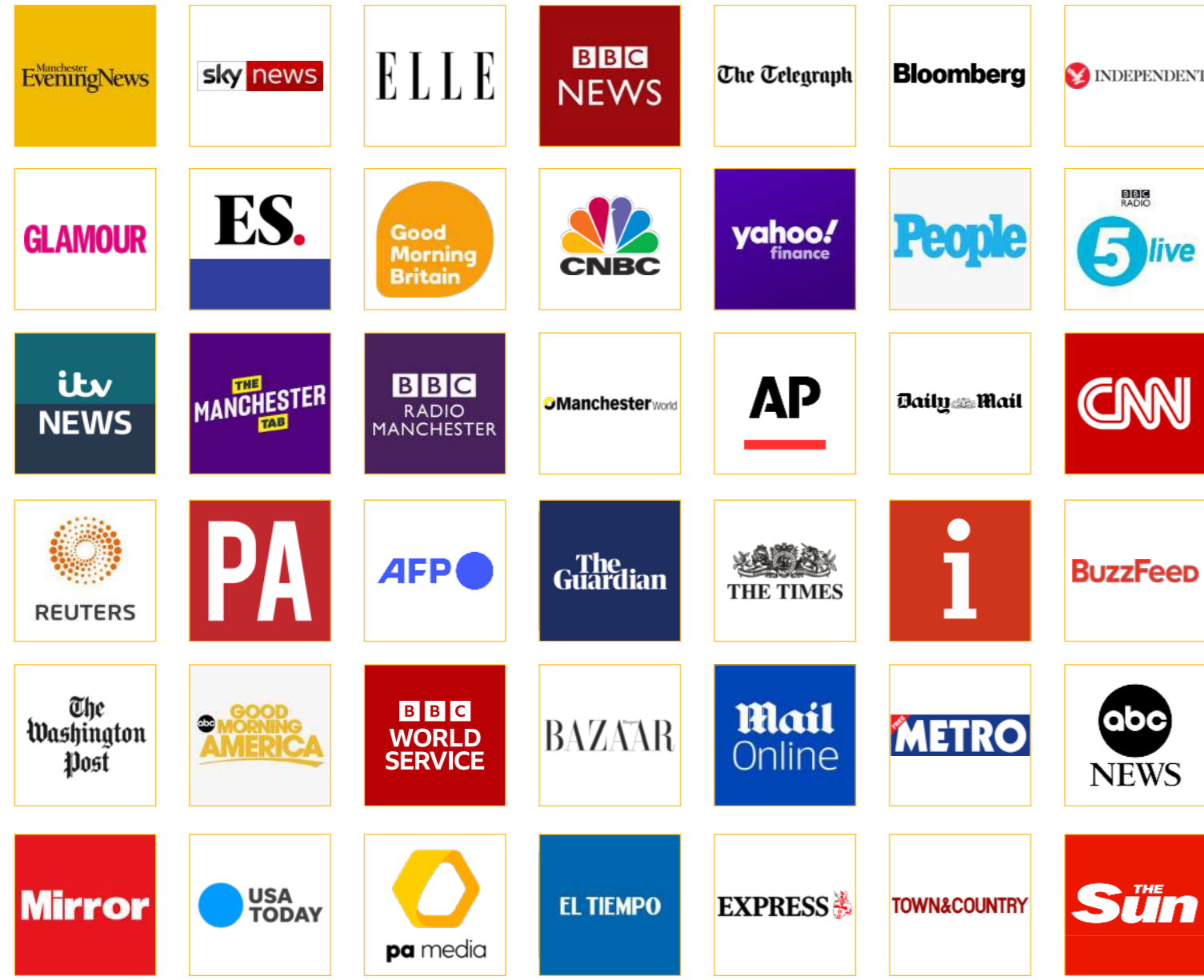

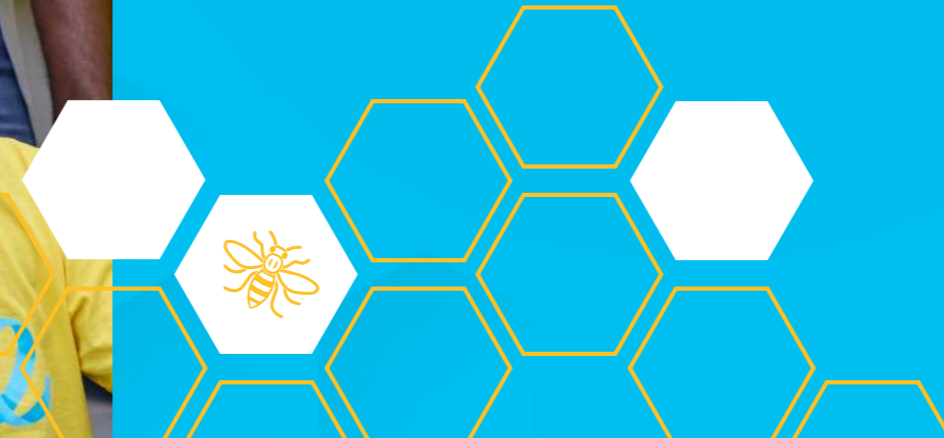

The Women Behind The NFT Boom

Selling for millions, owned by everyone from Justin Bieber to Gwyneth Paltrow, NFTs have become huge business in the art world. But now the once-mystifying digital assets are booming in fashion, activism, even poetry – and it's driven by women. Hattie Crisell investigates.

Similarly, Soy Fira is a Colombian artist whose NFTs found an audience during the Covid-19 lockdown. 'Everything I made was in my room, just with my computer, my phone and the curiosity of wanting to connect with people,' she says. She's sold her work in 30 countries, with one of her paintings selected to go into space with Jeff Bezos; she's trying to keep the door open for other women, and has recently sold five NFTs to raise funds for One Young World, a forum for young leaders. 'In my country, women often don't work – they're the ones who take care of the children. I want more girls to have this opportunity in tech, so that they can be independent.'

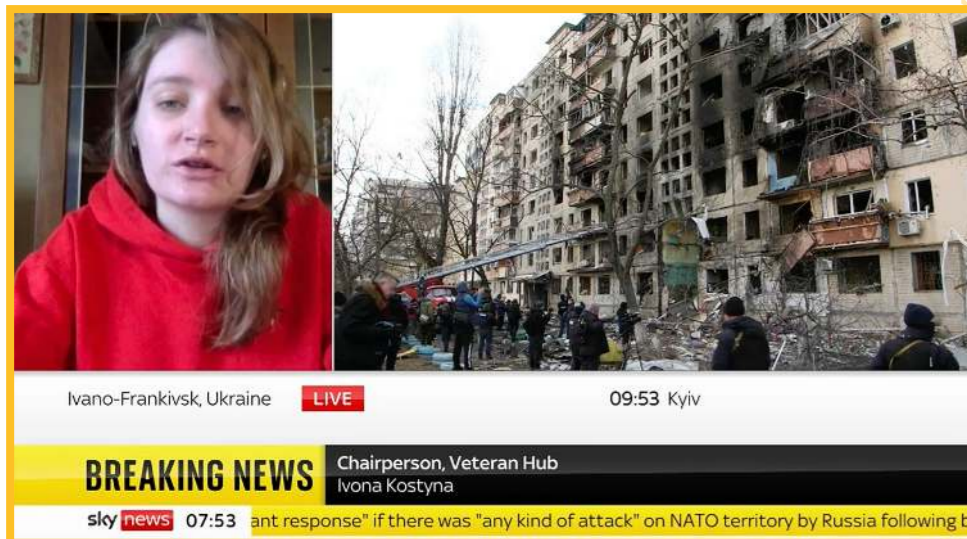


A view from Sri Lanka: OYW Ambassador speaks to Times Radio

Purpose isn't just a numbers game

No one wants to be embarrassed to tell their friends who they work for, especially when so many people are turning away from the corporate world.

It's no surprise that the upheaval of a global pandemic, combined with increasing anxiety about climate change, and a renewed focus on racial justice have pushed businesses to place greater emphasis on purpose and sustainability. No one wants to be embarrassed to tell their friends who they work for, especially when so many people are turning away from the corporate world.

In 2021, research from McKinsey found that 70% of employees find their sense of purpose defined by work, yet only 18% believed that they get as much purpose from work as they want. The world of work is being disrupted by the next generation, who have a transformative understanding of what constitutes a “meaningful” career. Businesses need to adapt alongside this change, or they risk hemorrhaging talent.

Manchester to host world's largest youth summit

Manchester has been chosen to host the world's largest youth summit.

More than 2,000 young delegates from 190 countries will gather in September to share ideas about how best to drive social change.

Tokyo had been due to stage One Young World 2022 but will miss out due to uncertainty over Covid restrictions.

Chancellor Rishi Sunak said he "could not think of anywhere more fitting" for the event as he praised Manchester's vibrancy and creative thinking.

The 2022 forum is to focus on conflict prevention, safeguarding oceans, and ethical leadership, its organisers said.

The young leaders will be supported by Nobel Peace laureates, heads of state and activists.

Counsellors for this year's event have yet to be announced but figures have previously included Kofi Annan, Sir Bob Geldof, Justin Trudeau, Emma Watson and Meghan Markle.

Previous summits have taken place in Ottawa, Bangkok, The Hague and Munich.

Manchester to host 2022's One Young World summit

Over 2,000 delegates from more than 190 countries will be in attendance from September 5 to 8

One Young World has built a network of more than 13,500 ambassadors and in previous years, the leaders of the summit have included Nobel Laureate Professor Muhammad Yunus, the Duchess of Sussex, President Mary Robinson, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, the late Kofi Annan, and Emma Watson.

Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Canada, described One Young World as: "An unparalleled network of forward-thinking, progressive leaders from every corner of the world."

The summit, and One Young World, prioritise action over debate and has been responsible for poignant programs including COVID-19 Young Leaders Fund, Lead2030 and One Young World Academy.

Kate Robertson and David Jones, the co-founders of One Young World said: "We're delighted to bring the One Young World Summit to Manchester in September."

One Young World: global summit for influential youth leaders is coming to Manchester

The arrival of the prestigious event in the city has been warmly welcomed by regional and national politicians.

The event will get under way on 5 September with an opening ceremony at [The Bridgewater Hall](#) before the rest of the conference which goes on until 8 September and involves speeches, panels, workshops and networking sessions.

More than 2,000 young people from around 190 countries are expected in Manchester to discuss topics such as conflict prevention, ethical leadership, safeguarding the oceans, gender equality and ensuring health equity for all.

Since launching in 2009 the organisation has built up a network of some 135,000 young ambassadors.

High-profile young people expected in Manchester include Tabata Amaral, a Brazilian Congresswoman for Sao Paulo aged just 24 who has drawn comparisons with influential American politician Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez.

There will also be two local Manchester ambassadors attending.

Manchester to host One Young World 2022 Summit

One young World, a global community of young leaders, has announced that Manchester will host its global summit from 5-8 September 2022.

The community has over 13,500 young ambassadors, over 2,000 of which will attend the summit, representing more than 190 countries.

At the Summit, attendees discuss and explore solutions to an array of topics, including conflict prevention, ethical leadership, safeguarding our oceans, gender equality and ensuring health equity for all.

Other delegates alongside the young leaders will include high-profile leaders who will share their experiences of creating positive social impact. Previous attendees of the event include: Nobel Laureate Professor Muhammad Yunus, the Duchess of Sussex, President Mary Robinson, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, the late Kofi Annan and Emma Watson.

Kate Robertson and David Jones, co-founders, One Young World, said: "From football and music to innovation, Manchester is known around the world as a city that truly inspires young people, not least in its efforts to become a fairer, greener place to live and work."

"We know it will be a truly inspirational host for the One Young World delegates and the team is excited to make the Summit in September the best one yet for everyone attending in-person and virtually."

So I couldn't think of anywhere more fitting to host this year's summit. Thousands of delegates including the most inspirational young minds will come together to strike up new connections and share the new ideas that will have a lasting positive impact for the world."

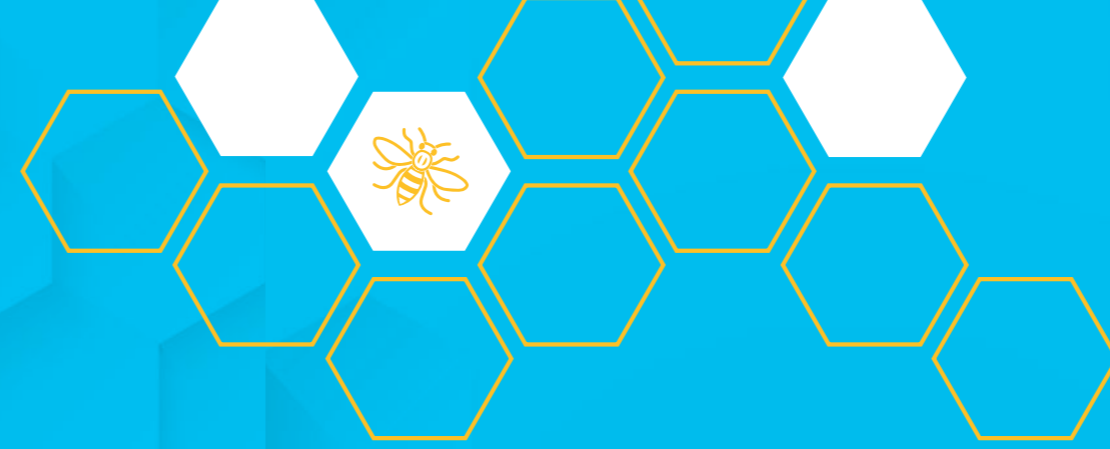

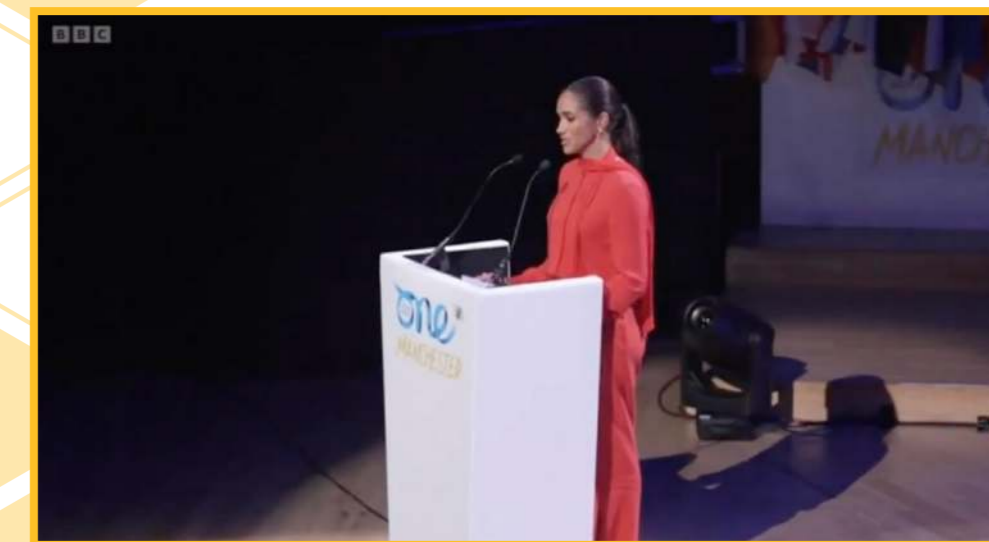

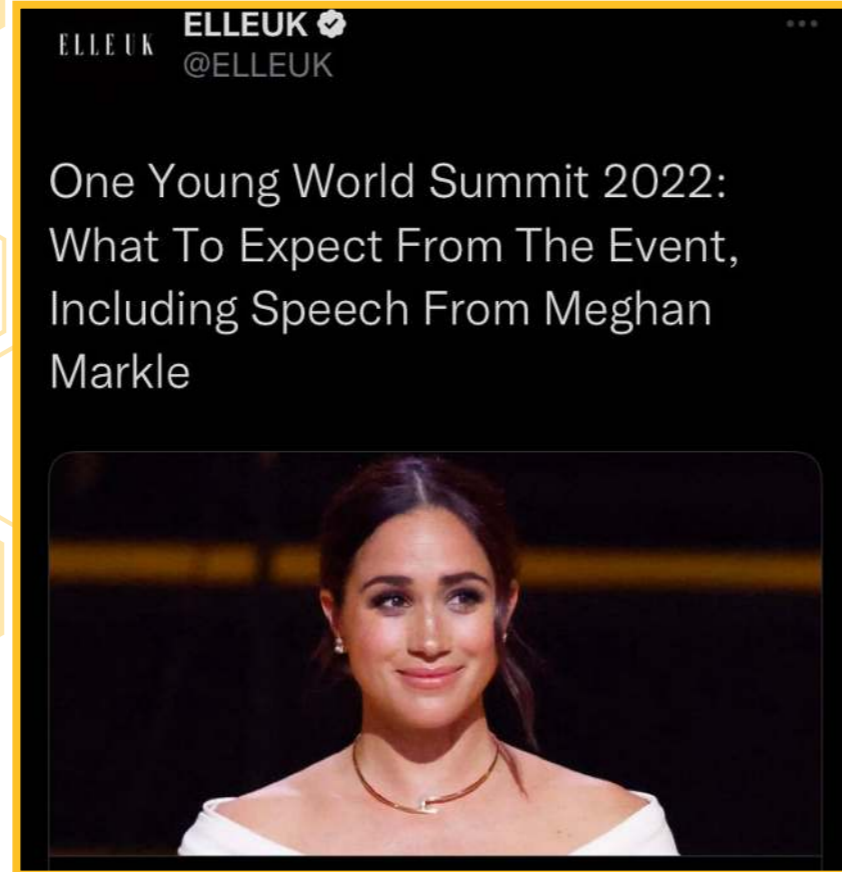

The event hopes to create a space for young people to come together and build connections and serve as a platform for young voices across the globe.

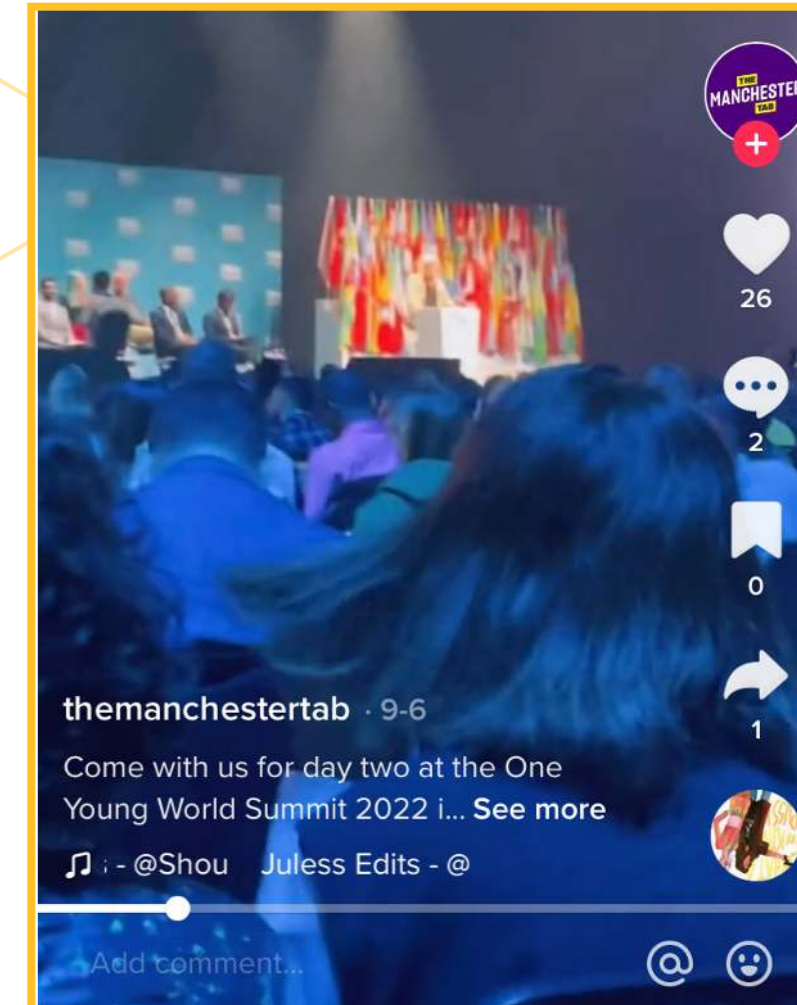

There were numerous opportunities to nurture ideas and connect with people with similar ambitions.

Inspiring and heartfelt stories of ambitious leaders committing to social action via their initiatives were all but commonplace as talent from Manchester Central shone through. It was truly inspirational to hear the impacts they are having locally, nationally, and internationally. We spoke to various young leaders to understand what their journeys looked like and take away some knowledge they had learnt along their journeys.

Ahmed Ali, founder of Code, made a tech hub to support Sudanese students to study programming and mobile app development to prepare for the fast-changing market, locally and globally. After developing these skills himself, he noticed an opportunity to help others develop and grow. In a truly inspiring story, Ahmed describes the importance of resilience, having had to promote social change through revolutions and coups within Sudan. He shared the value of sustainability and education to nurture the capabilities of the youth.


OYW is the global community for young leaders. Its mission is to create a fair, sustainable future for all, by developing young leaders who are taking action to solve the world's big challenges.
